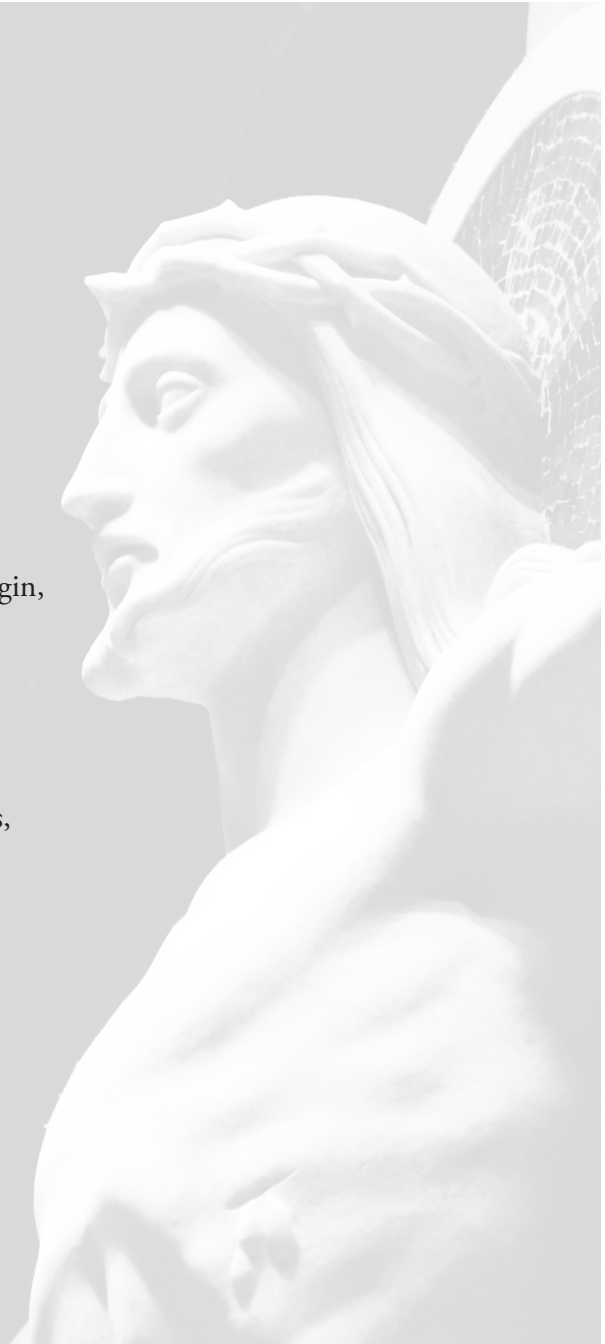


**First Reading:** Isaiah 56:1, 6-7






