The Cathedral of Christ the King's livestream service allows you to share your special day with friends and family who are unable to attend in person, as well as provide a lasting recording of your wedding ceremony.

With CTK's in-house system of four (4) HD PTZ cameras and HQ audio, we offer a multi-camera, broadcast-quality livestream of your wedding ceremony.

Here is a more detailed breakdown of what we offer and how it works:

How much does this cost?

The fee for the livestream service is \$200. This covers everything described in this document, and is unable to be modified.

50% of the fee is given to the Cathedral, and will contribute to the ongoing upkeep of our camera and audio systems. 50% of the fee is given to the team member who produces the livestream, as a courtesy for their time and talent.

How is the production quality?

Similar to our <u>Sunday services</u>, we assign an experienced member of our livestream team to direct the production. They will control our four in-house PTZ (Pan-Tilt-Zoom) cameras to dynamically capture your wedding ceremony from multiple angles.

Also, the livestream's audio is connected to our in-house audio, directly capturing the officiant's microphone, ambo (lectern) microphone, and in-room music microphones.

Here is a previous wedding livestream you may view to provide an example of what you may similarly expect for your own wedding.

How do people watch live?

All streams are broadcast live on our livestream page:

<u>cathedralctk.com/livestream</u>. You may share this link to anyone who wishes to view the ceremony in real time.

The broadcast will play in the large Vimeo media player embedded at the top of the page, and will start playing automatically once the livestream director has begun the broadcast.

The stream will go live approximately 5 minutes prior to the start of your ceremony. If you would like the stream to start sooner (for example, if you have a family member singing a song before the ceremony), you may indicate that request to our livestream coordinator at livestream@ctking.com

Will I get a recording afterwards?

You sure will! After the broadcast is no longer live, Vimeo will create a unique URL where you may replay and/or download an HD recording of the ceremony.

This URL will be shared with you by our livestream coordinator soon after your wedding week. You may then share the link with anyone.

The recording will also remain uploaded to our Vimeo account, unless you request it to be removed.

Does this replace the need for a wedding videographer?

The short answer: **no!** Our service should *not* be considered a comparable replacement for professional vendors who specialize in high-end wedding video production. (And while we're sure your wedding reception will be camera-worthy, our coverage ends at the conclusion of the ceremony.)

That said, depending on your needs and budget, the CTK livestream may be a great alternative for capturing a recording of the ceremony, if you are otherwise *not* planning on hiring a professional videographer.

Furthermore, the livestream may be an excellent *addition* to complement the work of a wedding videographer, offering alternate camera angles and audio options.

Could there be technical difficulties?

As is the case with any technology, no matter how sophisticated: problems can occur. Although *rare*, please understand that unforeseen technical difficulties may arise before or during your ceremony that can impact the quality of the production, or our ability to broadcast.

Should an issue arise, our team will take every measure to troubleshoot and ensure a high-quality stream is still successful.

In the unlikely scenario that we are *unable* to successfully produce your livestream, the Cathedral staff will reach out regarding remedial next steps, such as refunding your livestream fee.

What is the deadline to reserve this service?

In order to ensure adequate advance to schedule and secure the personnel required, livestreams must be reserved **one month before the date of the wedding.**

Any livestream request within one month of your wedding date might still be able to be honored, but is not guaranteed.
